History/Risk Factors: History: smoking, occupational, medical, family. Assess for orthopnea. Second-hand smoke exposure. Allergies. Indoor/outdoor air pollution. Symptoms: shortness of breath at rest or on exertion, activity limitation, cough, sputum production (amount, colour, consistency), wheezing, chest tightness.
