squeeze the muscles as hard as you can for about 5 seconds It is important to really feel the tension in the muscles, which may even cause a bit of discomfort or shaking In this instance, you would be making a tight fist with your left hand It is easy to accidentally tense other surrounding muscles (for example, the shoulder or
